

PFLAG Cedar Rapids is proud to announce the **Lorinda Ampey PFLAG Scholarship** to outstanding Iowa high school seniors or post-secondary students who advocate and educate their schools, communities, themselves and/or their families about human rights. Academic persistence, extracurricular activities, specifically active in their school's GSA and/or community involvement forwarding social justice also factor into the awards.

The scholarships are a minimum of \$100 each. The number of awards varies each year based on the number and quality of applicants and the funds available.

Applicants must be Iowa residents and plan to pursue post-secondary education. There is no restriction on the type or location of the institution where post-secondary education is obtained. Scholarships are awarded without regard to age, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, transgender status, race, religion, marital status or employment status of the prospective recipient.
